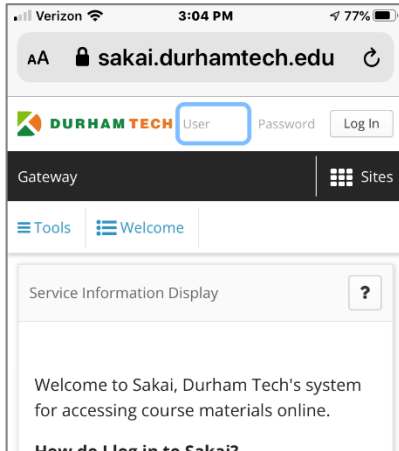
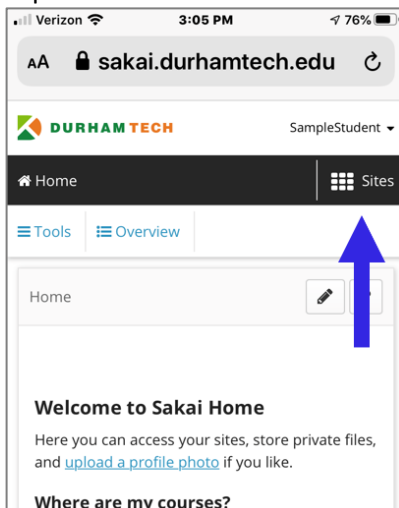


Sakai Help for Students: Uploading an Image on Your Phone to an Assignment in Sakai

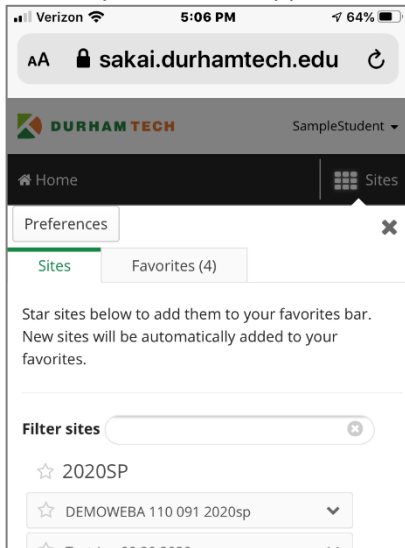
1. Use your phone to take a picture of the work you will be sharing with your instructor.
2. Open your phone's web browser and type in **sakai.durhamtech.edu** in the address bar. Log in to Sakai with your Durham Tech Username and password.



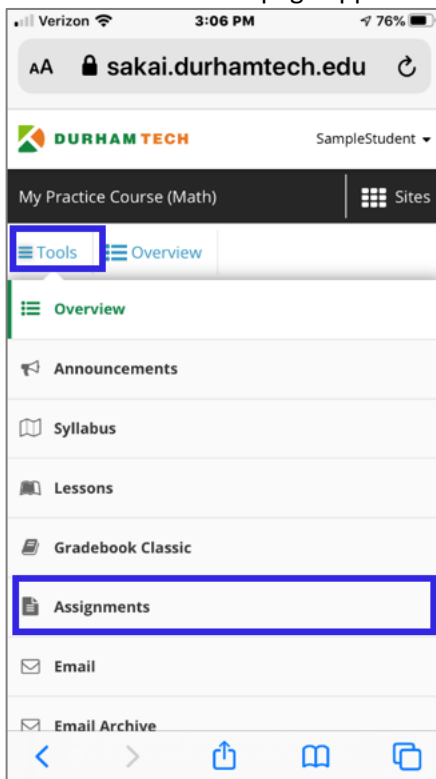
3. Tap Sites.



4. A list of your courses appears. **Scroll down** and **tap** the course you need.

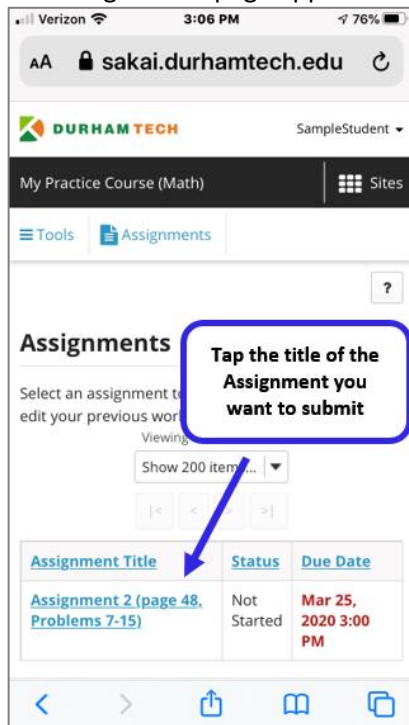


5. The course Overview page appears. Tap **Tools** and the course menu appears. Tap **Assignments**.

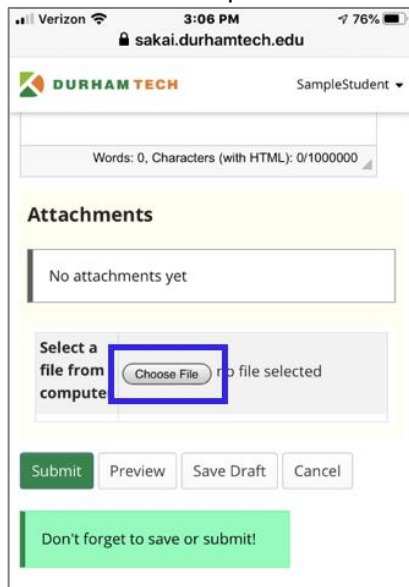


(If you do not see Assignments on the course menu, go to the place where your instructor usually posts the assignment link.)

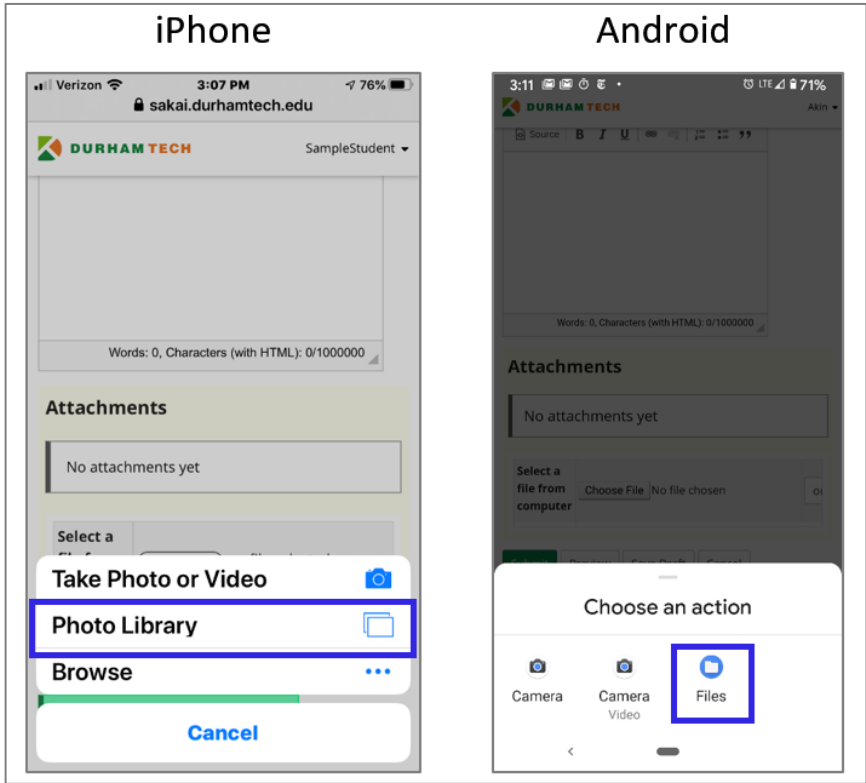
6. The Assignments page appears. Tap the **title of assignment** you want to submit.



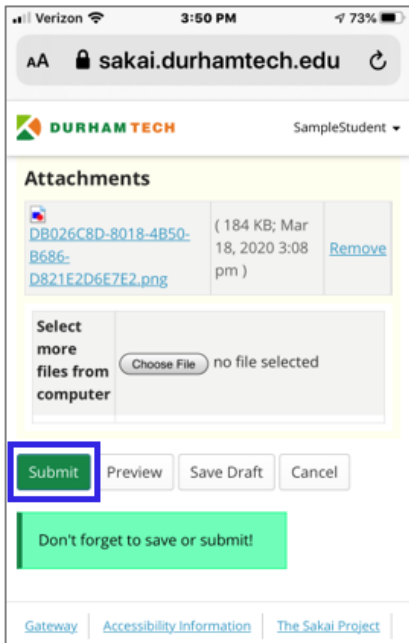
7. Scroll down and tap **Choose File**.



8. Your phone will ask you to locate the file you want to use.
 On an **iPhone**, select **Photo Library**. On an **Android** device, select **Files**.
 (Note: Android devices may first ask if Chrome can use the camera, select No).



9. Locate the image in your phone's library, and then tap to select it. A link to the file appears in the Attachments area in Sakai. **Make sure to tap Submit!**



10. A submission confirmation message appears. Your image has been successfully submitted in the assignment.
