Collecting and Sorting Discussion Board Posts in Blackboard

Blackboard's Collect feature allows instructors to compile Discussion Board postings for quick viewing in one place. Once posts are collected they can be sorted several different ways for easy reading.

- 1. Select the thread(s) you want to view
- 2. Click the Collect button
- 3. Select All posts and Click Go
- 4. Sort posts by Author's First Name, Author's Last Name, Date, Subject, Thread Order, Ascending or Descending and Click Go

Why should I use the Collect and Sort features?

- Check student discussion board participation and track attendance for the week by using Collect and Sort by Author's Last Name
- Read the thread discussion in one screen by using Collect and Sort by Thread Order
- Use Collect and Sort by Thread Order then save a PDF copy for future reference
- Quickly search the document by using the Find feature (Ctrl + F)
