

What's New in Blackboard 7.3?

We have highlighted some of the most useful new features of Blackboard 7.3 in this handout. Please note that it is not an all inclusive list of all the new features.

Discussion Board - Huge Improvements!

Forum	Total Posts	Unread Posts	Total Participants
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The Discussion Board has several newly improved features! Use this forum to post a message and reply to others to familiarize yourself with the improved format of the discussion board. You might even pick up a tip or two along the way!

Unread Posts
Collects all unread posts in one window.

Mark Read/Unread
You now have the ability to mark posts read or unread! Unread posts appear in bold.

Tree View
Return of the tree view! The tree view allows you to expand or collapse all postings. You can toggle between the tree and list views.

Search Box
You can now hide the search box to free up screen space. Unhide when you need to search for posts.

Sorting - Improved!

Sorting actually works in this version! You can now sort by thread order to keep the thread intact.

Lock Forums

Instructors can once again lock threads to prevent new postings, but still allow users to review existing postings.

NOTE: Threads can only be locked when in the **List View**.

Forum Availability - Improved!

When you make discussion forums unavailable a note now appears letting you know the forum is unavailable. Choose date/time restrictions to automatically display the forum for a specific amount of time.

Subscribe - New Feature!

You can allow students to subscribe to threads or a forum. Students who choose to subscribe will receive email notification of new posts.

Announcements - New Feature! (Step 4)

Email an Announcement

Step 4 of the new announcement setup process allows you the option of emailing a course announcement to all course users.

4 Email Announcement

Email will be sent immediately to all course users. Note that Course Links will not be included in the email.

Email this announcement to all course users.

Email Format


The format of the email that the user will receive is:

Subject of email = course name: announcement title

Body of email = announcement

Note: Course Links will not be included in the email

Messages - Improvements!

Send Email - Additions!

New Category

All Student Users (Send email to all of the Student users in the Course)

Sender

The send email feature now includes the sender's name as well as the sender's email address in the From field

Gradebook – Additions!

Modify Comments

Instructors can now add comments to student work (tests, assignments, quizzes, etc.) in the gradebook. The Modify Comments button will appear once grades have been entered manually or automatically.

Enter or modify a grade for the assignment. Click **View** to access files sent by the user, to enter feedback or instructor notes, or to send a file to the user.
