	Take an online Test or Quiz as a student
	Create and publish an online Test or Quiz
	Have a basic understanding of the processes below and be able to locate step-by-step instructions to perform them:
	 Grading Forum posts and providing feedback to students
	 Grading Assignments and releasing grades and feedback to students
	 Grading Tests & Quizzes and releasing grades and feedback to students
