	<ul> <li>Set up your Gradebook for your course site</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Create a Gradebook item and enter student grades</li> </ul>
	Forum:
	<ul> <li>Submit Forum posts and replies</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Set up Forum topics for online class discussions</li> </ul>
	Assignments:
	<ul> <li>Submit a file in Assignments as a student</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Set up an <b>Assignment</b> to collect files from students (enabling Turnitin for plagiarism- checking, if desired)</li> </ul>
	Tests & Quizzes:
	o Take an online <b>Test or Quiz</b> as a student
	<ul> <li>Create and publish an online Test or Quiz</li> </ul>
	Have a basic understanding of the processes below and be able to locate step-by-step instructions to perform them:

	<ul> <li>Grading Forum posts and providing feedback to students</li> </ul>
