

Discussion Board

The Discussion Board feature did not change in version 8. However, there are some bugs affecting the way initial threads appear in the Thread Detail View.

You will notice that the subject of initial threads (only) now appear in a slightly larger font. The subject of these posts also appear to be bold even though they have been read. This bug does not seem to affect replies to the initial thread.

When in doubt, check out the user's name. The user's name will appear bold when posts are unread and unbold when posts are read. This is a very minor cosmetic issue and does not affect the way the Discussion Board works in other ways.
