

Sakai is a system for putting course materials online. Instructors can use Sakai in a variety of ways – for example, to provide course information, handouts, assignments, tests, grades, or online discussions. What computer hardware and software do I need to use Sakai?

To use Sakai you need:

- a computer (PC or Mac) with high-speed Internet access
- an email address
- a reasonably current web browser (Firefox or Chrome are recommended) Download Firefox: <u>https://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/new/</u> Download Chrome: <u>https://www.google.com/chrome/browser/</u>

How do I log in to Sakai?

For this training course, you'll logon to our Sakai Demo site:

- Go to the Sakai log in page: https://durhamtech.dev.longsight.com
- Enter your Sakai user id and password:
 - Your Sakai user id is the same as your Durham Tech/Web Advisor user name
 - Your Sakai password is the same as your Durham Tech/Web Advisor password
 Note: If you don't know or can't remember your password, don't worry -- just follow the steps below to reset (or set up) your password.

How do I reset (or set up) my password?

- Go to the Sakai Demo site log in page: <u>https://durhamtech.dev.longsight.com</u>
- Click the "**Reset Password**" link. Follow the prompts to reset or set up your password.
- When you finish, go to the Sakai Demo site login page at <u>https://durhamtech.dev.longsight.com</u> and log in using your Durham Tech user id and the password you just set up.
- *IMPORTANT:* Changing your Sakai password automatically changes your Durham Tech email and Web Advisor passwords too.

What do I do after logging in?

Sakai Tutorial: The first time you log in, a brief tutorial appears that gives basic info about using Sakai. After closing the tutorial, you can access it again at any time by clicking the User icon at the top right corner of the screen and selecting Tutorial.

Each time you log into Sakai, you land in "**Home**," an area where you can access your courses and store private files. Home also displays an aggregated Calendar and Recent Announcements from all of your course sites.

The first time you log into Sakai: On the menu to the left, click on "Account" to verify your email address. This is the address that email is sent from and to through Sakai.
